A **Studio 303** and **Studio XX** co-production

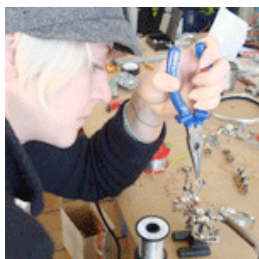
