Every two years, Studio XX produces HTMiles, a feminist festival in media arts and digital culture. The 13th edition of the HTMiles festival is an artistic response to the recent waves of online declarations. ***Beyond the # — Failures and Becomings*** looks at the role of digital technologies in this new space of expression, the reclaiming of voice, as well as obstacles and ways to successfully move forward. Artists, activists, and theorists redefine the foundations of success and failure and imagine new, emancipatory perspectives. The festival brings together exhibitions, discussions, a video screening, workshops, and performances.

WORKSHOP FOR FAMILIES *Filles en programmation : l'art génératif*

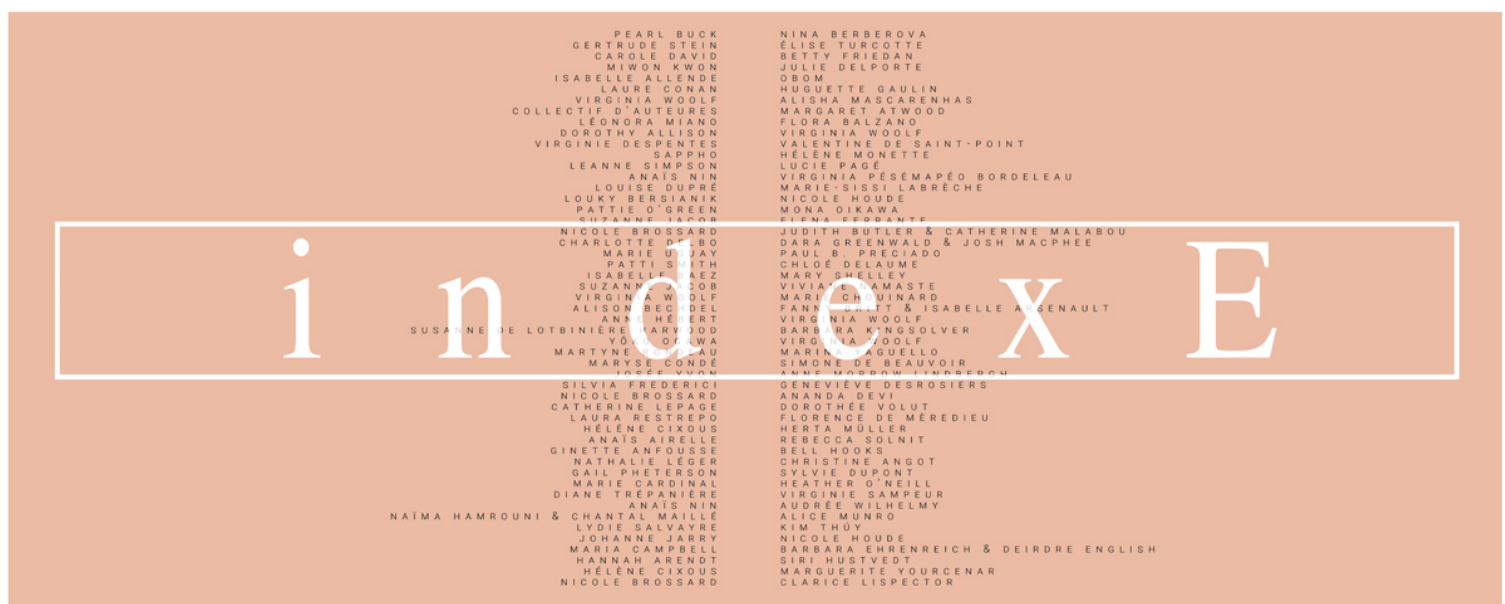

indexE brings together a series of invisible radio performances, a Web piece and two workshops. Drawing from a body of 100 books written by women, trans, non-binary and queer people, *indexE* raises the issue of women's invisibility in literature by using live voice and the Web as a place to share and transmit. This unseen voice, performed in a closed room, offers a reading of texts in order to "unforget" books selected by 100 people who were invited by the artist. This reading will be broadcasted live in the XX gallery and via [Studio XX' radio stream](#).

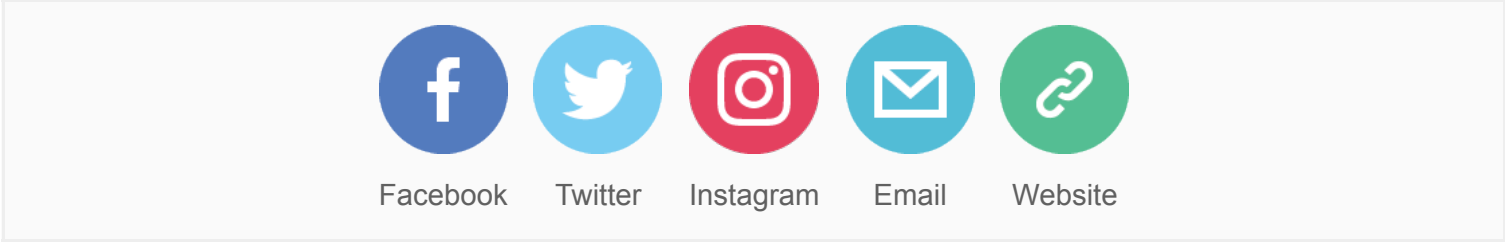
