



Book club: *Kindred* by Octavia Butler with <u>Anastasia Erickson</u>


Thursday October 8 and 15, 7pm – 9pm \Downarrow Online

In dialogue with the exhibition *A Harlem Nocturne* by Deanna Bowen, Anastasia Erickson's book club invites readers to discuss Octavia Butler's 1979 novel *Kindred*. 


Mapping Vidéo Fall 2020 (postponed) ↓ Ada X
