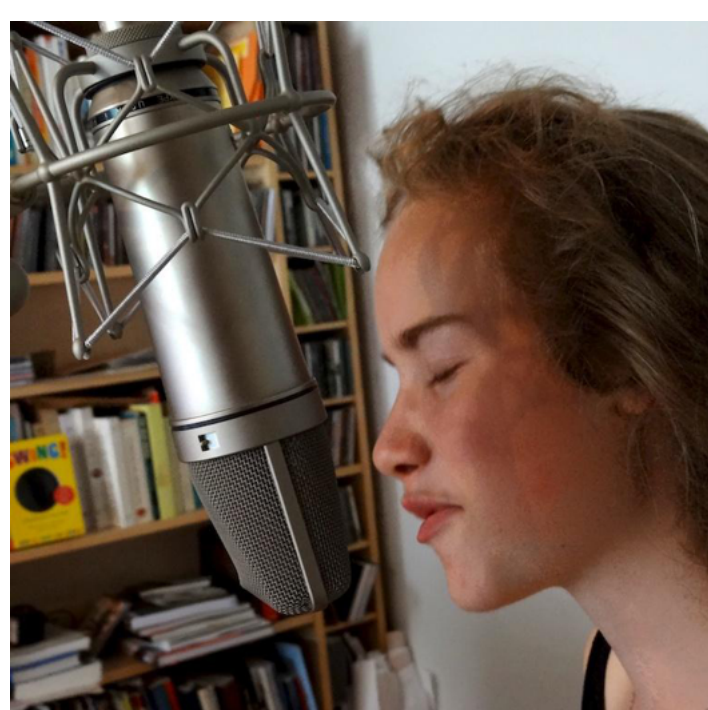

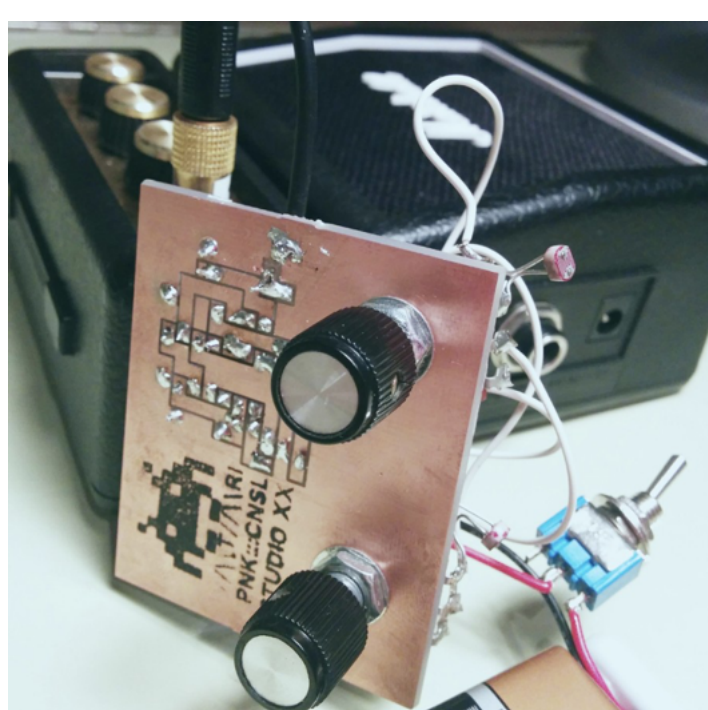


WORKSHOP DIGITAL AUDIO : CREATION AND PRODUCTION With Chantal Dumas

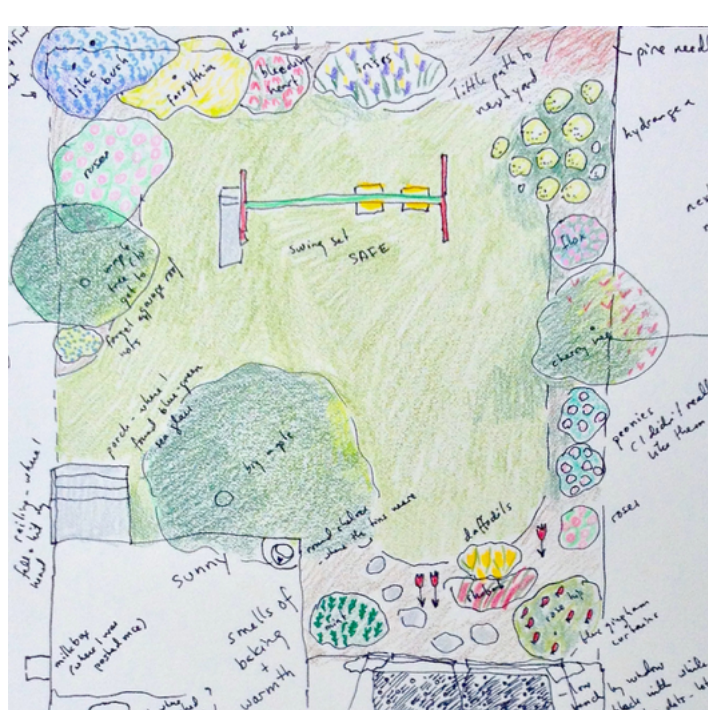

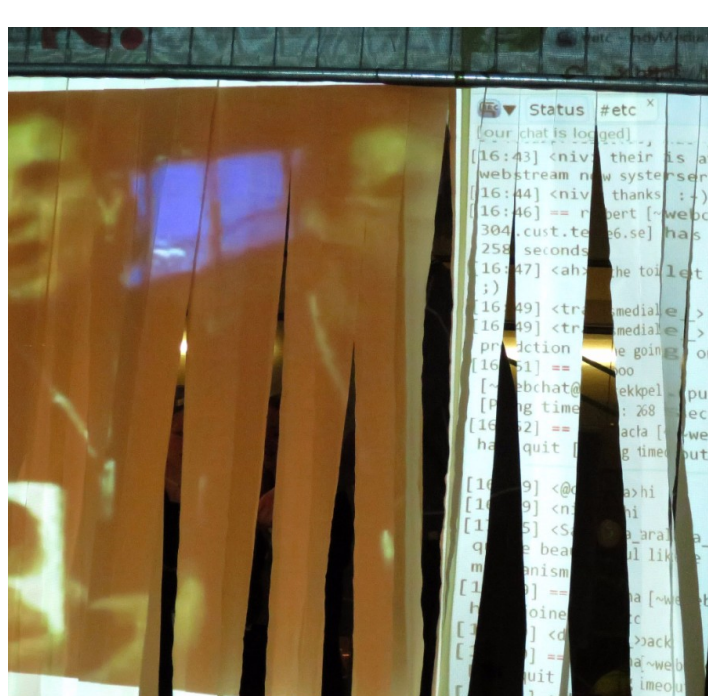

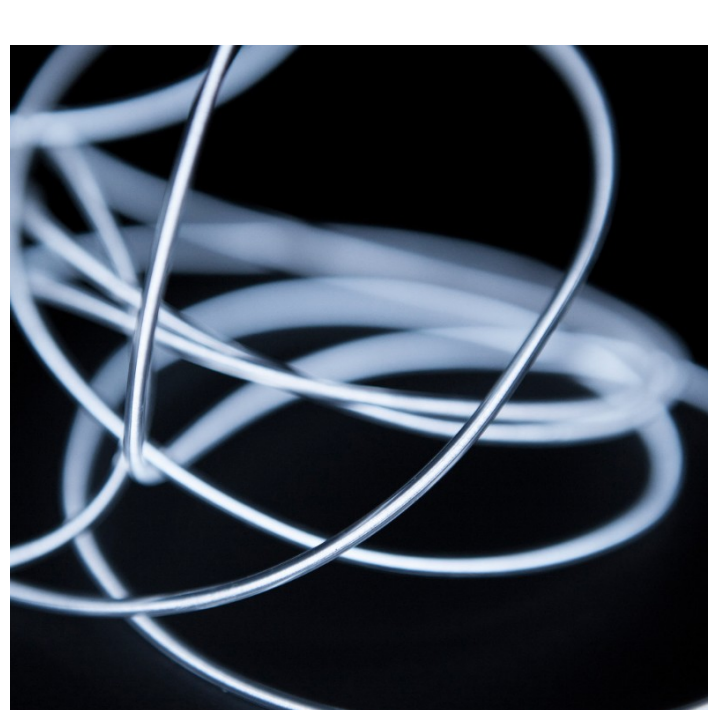


EXHIBITION COMMONS CLINIC Cornelia Sollfrank

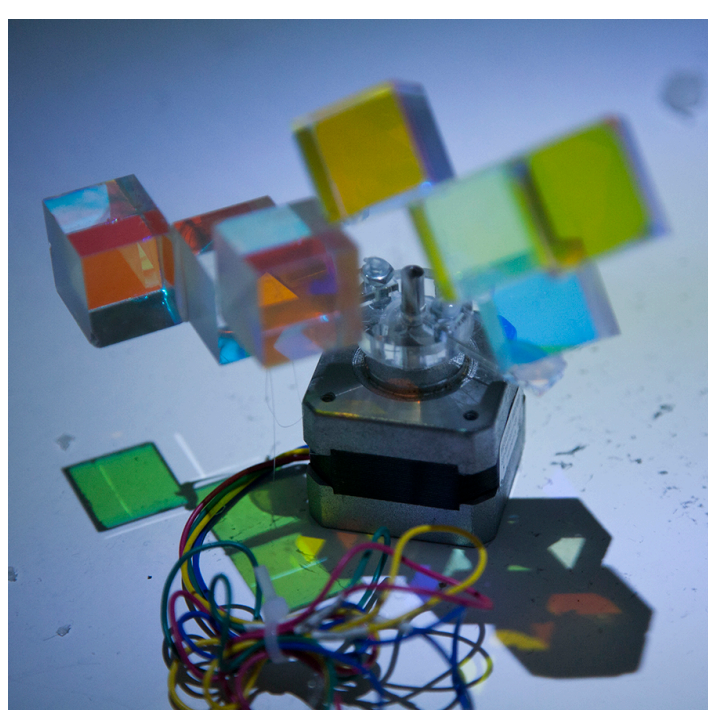

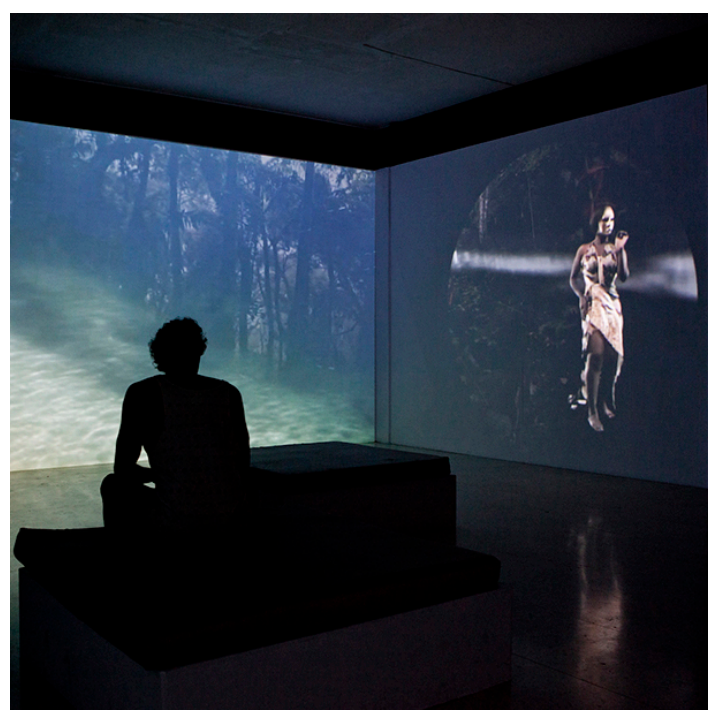

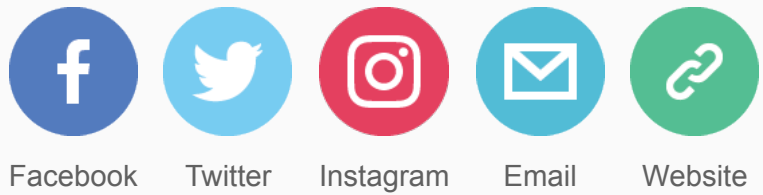
Participants will build basic electronic circuits using the live and colourful unicellular organism Physarum polycephalum to build and document a maze as part of a collective bioart project.
