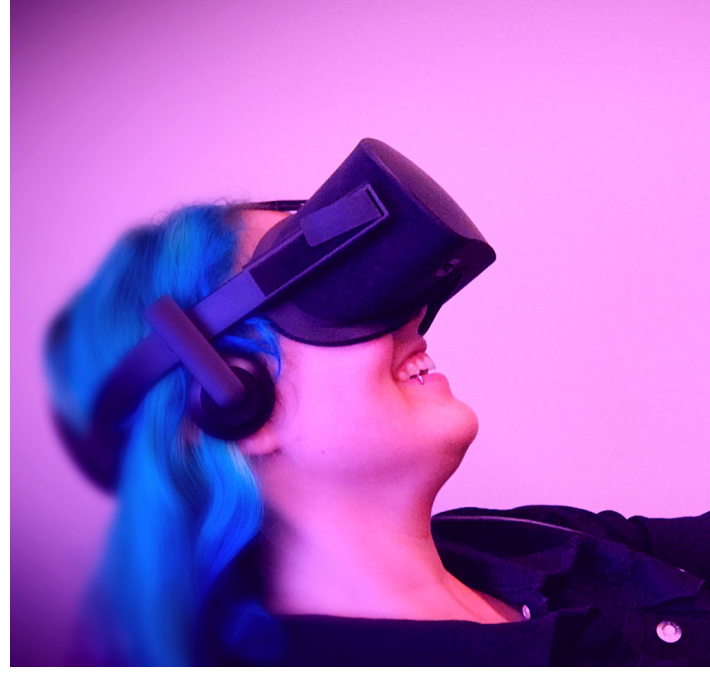
### WORKSHOP Video mapping: audiovisual intégration in 3D space

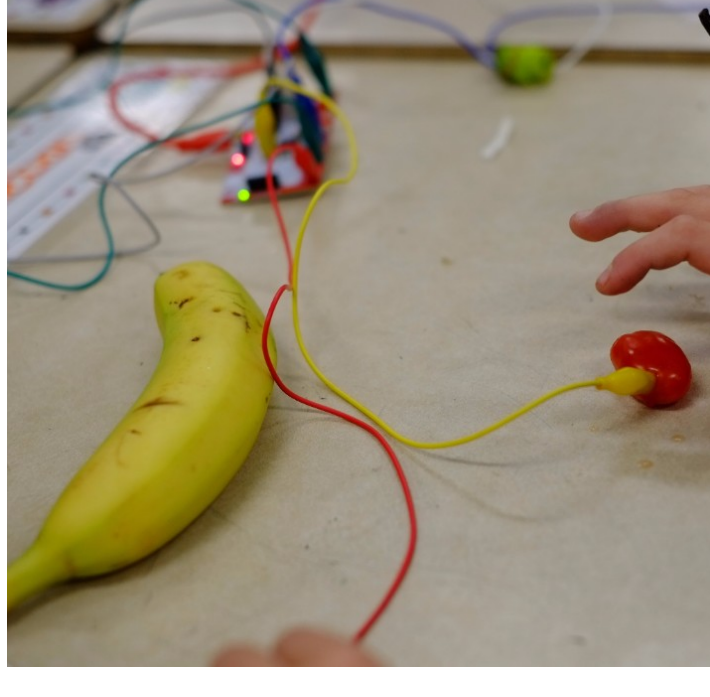

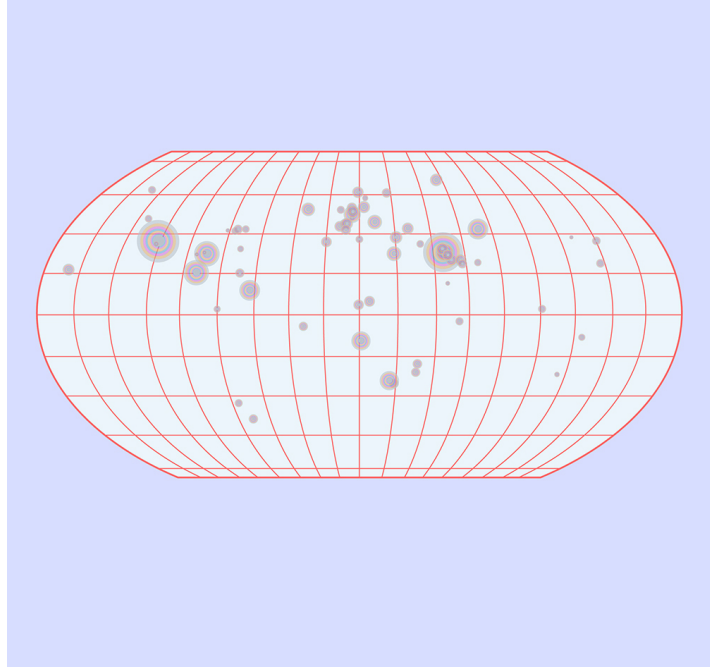
The participants will build small play circuits in everyday materials (modeling clay, aluminum foil, etc.) which will then be used to control a program of colored visualizations.

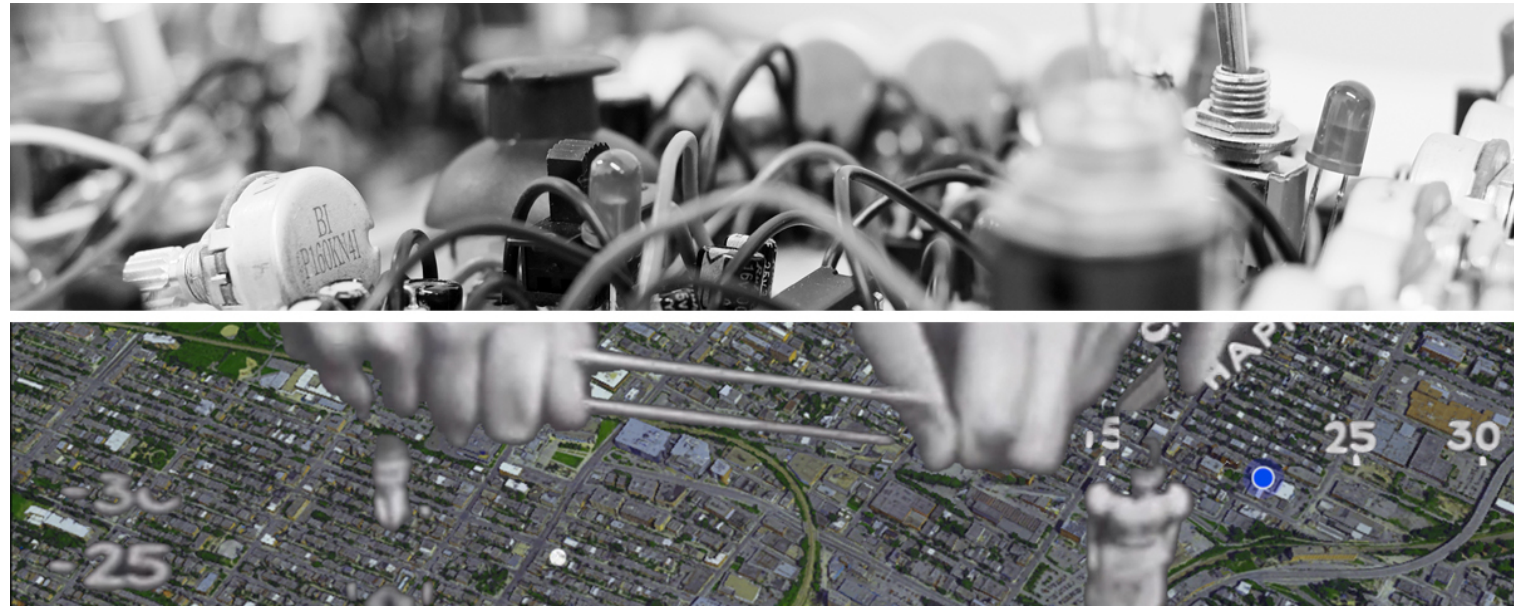

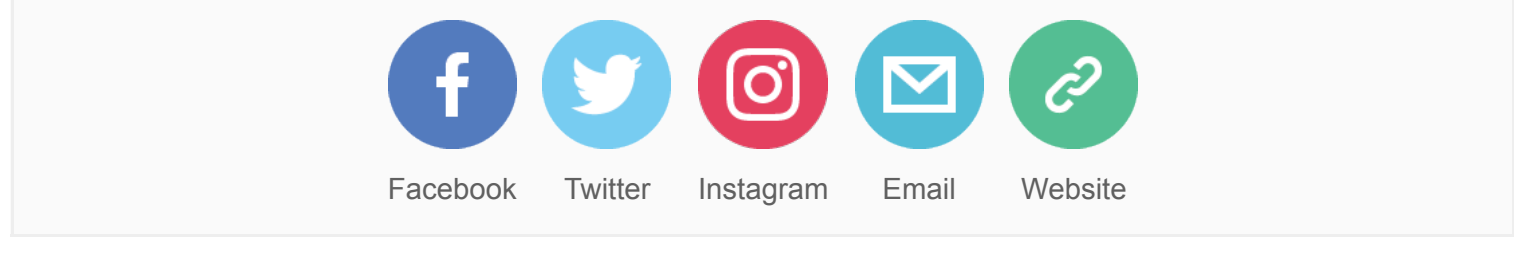


### EVENT | PROJECTION + DISCUSSION Silence et cacophonie : conversation entre le soi et l'autre
