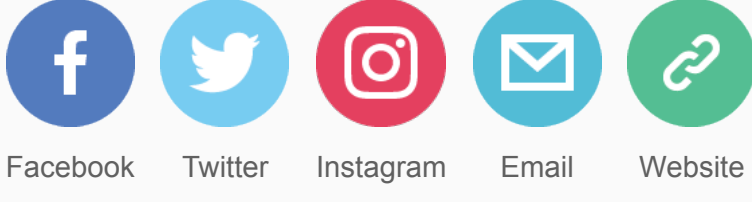


**WORKSHOP**
