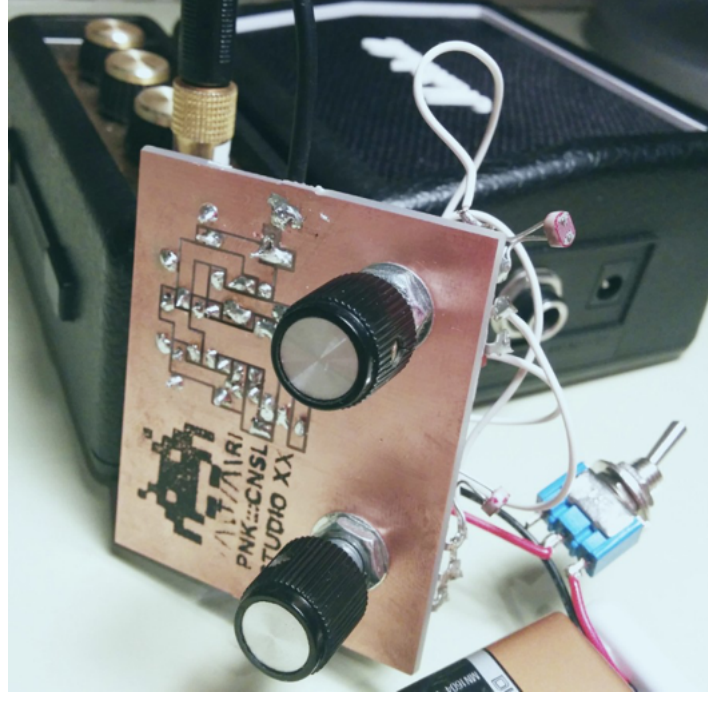
PROGRAMMING 2017 (EVENTS AND WORKSHOPS)

Participants will create their own audio art projects, each step in audio production will be covered: recording, editing, mixing; as well as learning to work with different playback formats and plug-ins.

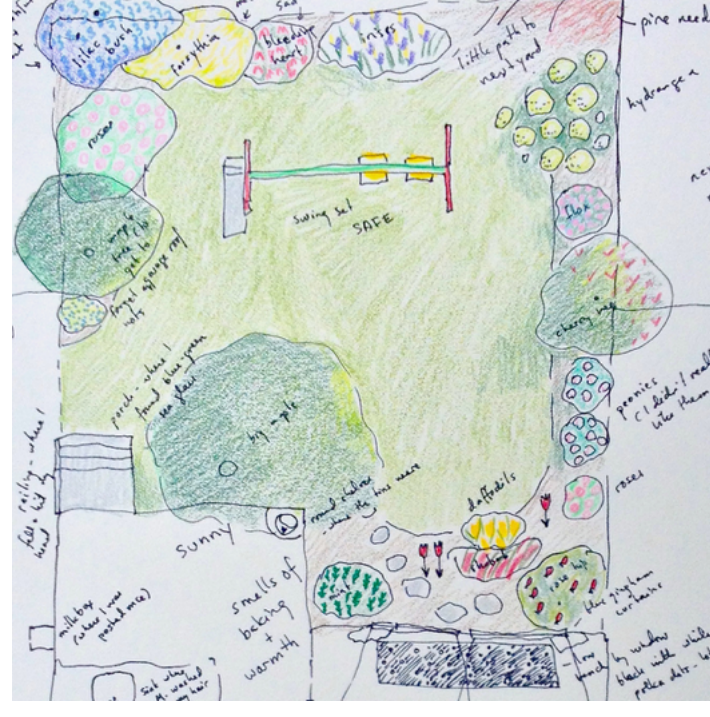

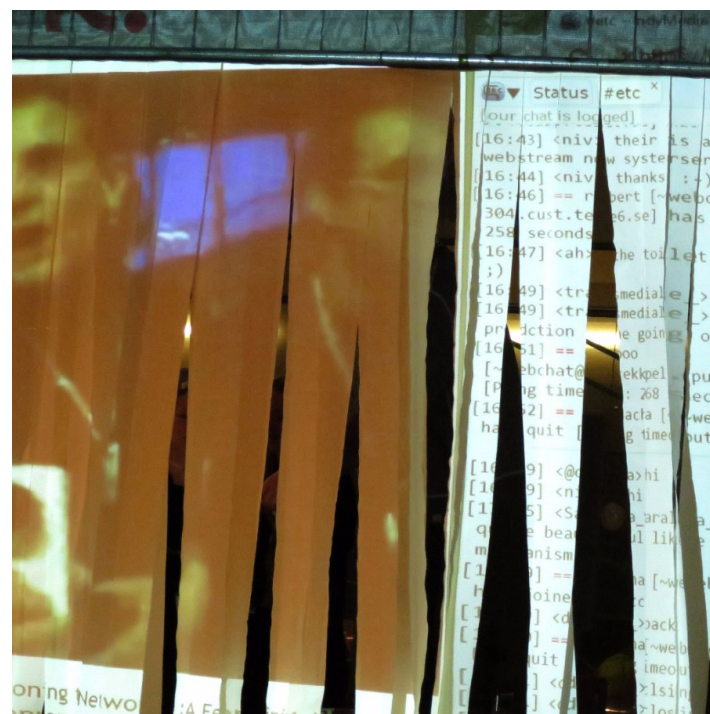


EXHIBITION SAFETY STRATEGIES: SPACE, GENDER AND THE CITY

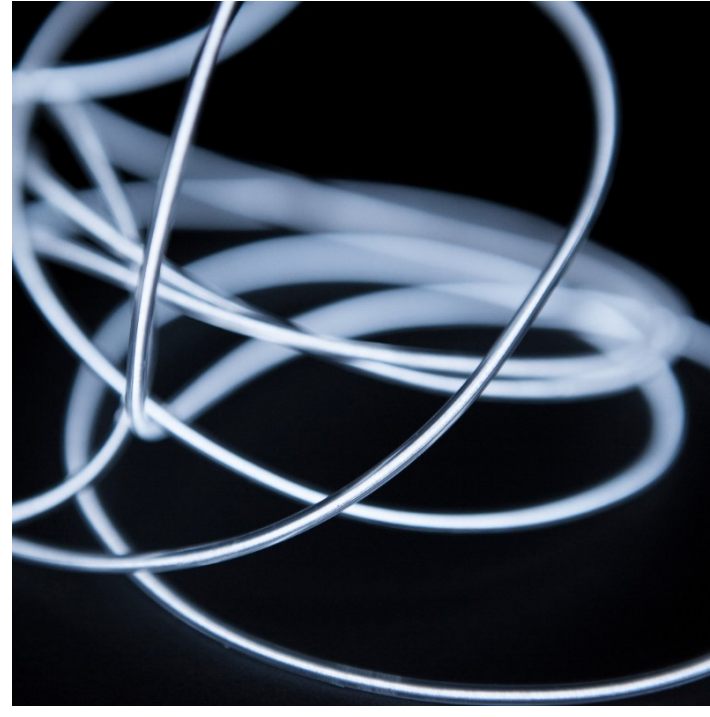

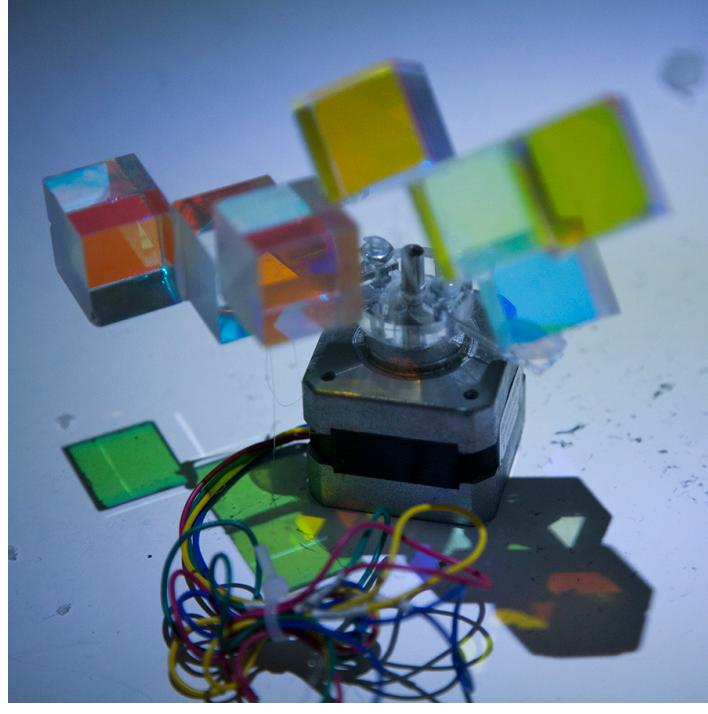

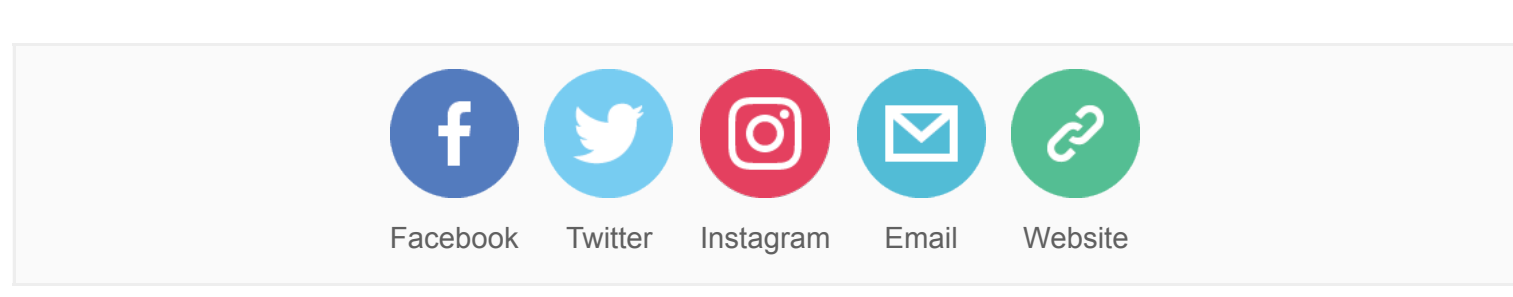
In this workshop, we will experiment with video mapping on 3D shapes and multi-screen video installations with poetry evocative of the theme of water.
