WORLD BRAIN - Stéphane Degoutin and Gwenola Wagon, Prod: Irrévérence Films
The Doghouse is a journey into the Internet. The exploration continues with an investigation of the dreams of a collective intelligence and the hypothesis of a world brain in the form of a film essay and an interactive site ([worldbrain.arte.tv](#)). The World Brain installation reconstructs one of the film's environments where a group of researchers try to survive in the woods using Wikipedia. The film is accompanied by a selection of books that reproduce the experience of the exploration, documents splintered like fragments on a cartographic carpet. [worldbrain.arte.tv](#)

THE MACHINE TO BE ANOTHER - BeanothLab
The Machine to Be Another is a long-term investigation into the relationship between identity and empathy inspired by recent findings in neuroscience. The Machine uses low-budget tools and embodiment techniques to let people see through the eyes of another, attempting to get as close as possible to replicating the subjective experience of someone else. It allows users to embody real people and real stories. A Creative Commons initiative, it has been replicated and applied in contexts ranging from art performances to conflict resolution, neuroscience and beyond.

THE DOGHOUSE - Mads Dambo, Johan Knatt rup Jensen
The Doghouse is a first-person reality film, an experience for five users at a time designed for Oculus Rift. A table is laid out in a room. On each plate is a pair of glasses and some headphones. Each guest sits down, puts on the glasses and plugs in the headphones, instantly finding himself at a family meal, Feiten style. The designers combine the roots of Dogma95 and immersion to create a revolutionary and exhilarating project.
